ENGLISH: all levels of ESL and English Language Arts, AP Language and Literature; **MANDARIN CHINESE:** all levels of Mandarin as a second language, Mandarin Language Arts, AP Chinese Language; **MATH:** Algebra, Geometry, Algebra 2/Trig, AP Statistics and AP Calculus; **SCIENCE:** Living Environment, Earth Science, Chemistry, Physics, AP Chemistry and/or Physics as we grow; **HISTORY:** Global, US History, Government and Economics, AP Government or AP US History as the school grows; **PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND HEALTH:** Also see our PSAL teams below; **ELECTIVES:** Art, music, computer science, linguistics, and other classes that meet the needs and interests of our students; **ADVISORIES:** small classes of students who support one another academically and emotionally, guided by the same teacher

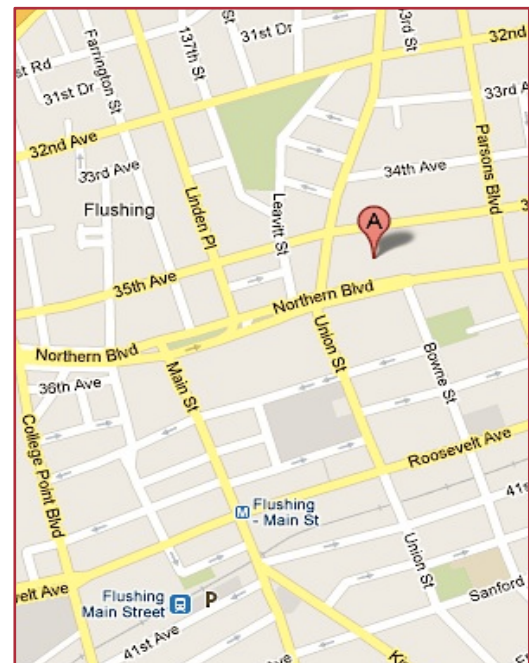


OUR LOCATION
